What you'll do as the LPN:

 - *Promoting the value, importance and need for diversity and inclusion within the whole community*
 - *Performing safe lifting and transferring techniques (training provided) - if/when needed.*
 - *Participating in the same events and activities as the individual(s) you are supporting (e.g. swimming), including transportation of supported individuals.*
 - *Promoting and supporting Individual rights and facilitating meaningful community inclusion.*
 - *Encouraging learning opportunities for personal growth and development for the individual(s) you are supporting.*
 - *Encouraging and creating opportunities for the development of personal relationships for the individual(s) you are supporting.*



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- *Supporting, guiding, mentoring, coaching and encouraging individuals to develop personal goals and supporting them to work towards achieving their goals.*
- *Promoting Positive Behaviour Supports and effective communication.*
- *This position requires Union membership (BCGEU)*

Qualifications that will help your application:

- *Diploma from an approved Practical Nursing Program and current registration with the BC College of Nurses (BCCNP)*
- *Valid Class 5 Driver's License and meet all other CSCL employment criteria (ie: Criminal Record Check, Medical Certificate, Covid Vaccination Requirements, etc)*
- *Must possess demonstrated experience delivering recreational, social, vocational, and/or life skills training*
- *Experience in completing nursing tasks related to diabetes and seizure management is essential*
- *Experience in alternative communication methods*
- *Excellent problem solving, decision making and creative thinking skills and demonstrated skills in crisis intervention and skills in dealing with challenging behaviours*
- *Excellent written and verbal communication and reporting skills in English*
- *Flexibility and availability to respond to calls for shift coverage*
