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## Qualifications that will help your application:

- Ability to prioritize and perform all basic maintenance and related duties.
- Possess a positive and friendly work attitude and have the ability to relate positively to the public, CSCL employees and individuals CSCL serves.
- Ability to work independently and provide guidance and support to other maintenance personnel.
- Ability to operate technology (ie: smart phone, computer) with associated applications (ie: technology systems used at CSCL) and complete required reporting
- Able to demonstrate understanding of CSCL's Mission, Vision and Values and an awareness of the value of a diverse community.
- Strong Health and Safety focus
- Able to meet the physical requirements of the position
- Use of own vehicle. Business Insurance and 3 million liability will be required.

- Willing to complete Criminal Record check
- Valid CPR and Emergency First Aid Certificate (or willing to obtain during probationary period)
